**AIR QUALITY ADVISORY ENDED FOR QUESNEL**

(February 13, 2025 7:00 AM) The Ministry of Environment and Parks in collaboration with the Northern Health Authority has ended the Air Quality Advisory that was issued February 12, 2025 for Quesnel due to elevated concentrations of fine particulate matter. Changing meteorological conditions have improved conditions across the region.

**Additional Information**

- The provincial air quality objective for PM<sub>2.5</sub> is 25 micrograms per cubic metre (µg/m<sup>3</sup>), averaged over 24 hours. 24-hour average PM<sub>2.5</sub> concentrations are summarized below for Quesnel and nearest monitored communities at 7:00 AM local time today:
