DUST ADVISORY ENDED FOR GOLDEN

(February 13, 2025 3:00 PM) The Ministry of Environment and Parks in collaboration with the Interior Health Authority has ended the Dust Advisory that was issued on February 12, 2025 for Golden due to elevated concentrations of dust. Changing meteorological conditions have improved conditions across the region.

 The provincial air quality objective for PM₁₀ is 50 micrograms per cubic metre (μg/m³), averaged over 24 hours. 24-hour average PM₁₀ concentrations are summarized below for Golden and nearest monitored communities at 3:00 PM local time today:
