Dear Mayor McEwen and Council:

Thank you for your letter of April 29, 2019, regarding the Village of Anmore's Liquid Waste Management Plan (LWMP). I am also in receipt of Juli Halliwell's May 1, 2019 email regarding the Village of Anmore's efforts to reconcile with Anmore Green Estates.

Ministry staff have reviewed the content of the submitted LWMP against the requirements of the Minister's August 16, 2018 order and the "Interim Guidelines for Preparing Liquid Waste Management Plans", 2011 (the [Guidelines](#)).

The order required that the LWMP must be prepared and signed by a qualified professional(s); however, the submission does not comply with this requirement. The Liquid Waste Management Guidelines outline a number of requirements that also were not included in Anmore's submission and an analysis of these requirements is attached to this email.

As the submitted plan is not in compliance with ministry guidelines, I cannot approve this LWMP as drafted without substantial revisions.

I would strongly advise the Village to have a qualified professional prepare and sign the LWMP, to consult ministry staff in preparing the plan, and undertake public consultation about the plan. I recognize this will take some time and, pursuant to the *Environmental Management Act*, Section 24(4), the Village of Anmore is hereby granted an extension to the deadline for submitting a LWMP. The new deadline is December 31, 2019. The order requirement for the LWMP to be prepared by a qualified professional(s) remains in force.
