Re: Armex Mining Corp. letter dated 3 April 2023 and subsequent discussion on Teams, Monday 8 May 2023, with regards to Tulsequah Mine

Thank you for letter of 3 April 2023 and subsequent conversation on MS Teams on 8 May 2023. I understand it is Armex's position that Armex is the secured creditor over the assets of the mine, and not the owner, nor the permittee. In your letter you also state: "*We note that since our interest is at present that of a secured creditor and not an owner of the Mine or holder of the Permit, we are not legally required to meet Chieftain's obligations nor are we, in a number of cases (as noted below) we legally empowered) [sic] to do so.*"

I do not agree with aspects of your letter, however, I agree that the deadline for compliance of the four orders made under s. 10.1 of the *Mines Act* be delayed until **December 31, 2023** to allow time to do a site visit and review information with consultants.

I will ask my staff to provide you with the following documents:

- Recent water monitoring data;
- A copy of the Conceptual Reclamation and Closure Plan and documents regarding the Water Treatment Facility

It would be appreciated if you can keep this office updated on your progress, in particular the dates of any site visits.
