The Water Protection and Sustainability Branch rescinds the 2003 B.C. interim Diisopropanolamine (DIPA) water quality guideline (WQGs) for the protection of drinking water sources of 21 mg/L (B.C. Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection, 2003). The source drinking WQG value of 3.5 mg/L (ENV, 2020) now applies to the Ambient Water Quality Guidelines for Diisopropanolamine (DIPA): Technical Appendix (B.C. Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection, 2003).
