Carbon Neutral Action Report Columbia Basin Trust Executive Summary CBT delivers programs and initiatives throughout the Columbia Basin that support carbon neutrality and climate change education and planning (see Objectives). In 2008, CBT acquired a further understanding of its new requirements and commitments under the Greenhouse Gas Reductions Targets Act ("GGRTA"). The focus for 2009 will be the development of a Carbon Neutral Plan ("Plan") which will include short and long term action plans. To assist in the development of this Plan, staff will be involved in a Carbon Neutral Planning Workshop. In June 2009, CBT will receive training on the new Smart Tool software that the Province has implemented for data gathering and reporting on greenhouse gas emissions. **Objectives** CBT delivers programs and initiatives throughout the Columbia Basin that support carbon neutrality and climate change education. While these programs/initiatives are delivered outside of the GGRTA requirements, they are an important part of CBTs contribution to the overall Province wide 2020 and 2050 GHG reduction targets. These programs and initiatives include, among others: 1. Numerous educational publications and presentations have been made available and delivered to residents and local governments throughout the Columbia River Basin: see http://www.cbt.org/Initiatives/Climate Change/?Publications 2. CBT is a partner in the Kootenay Regional Carbon Neutral Action Strategy, a project of the Central, East and Kootenay Boundary Regional Districts and all member municipalities, as well as the Ktunaxa Nation Council and Member bands. This program will support the 3 RDs and Kootenay Local Governments to meet and exceed their carbon neutrality commitments under the voluntary Climate Action Charter. CBT is leading regional action on Climate Change Adaptation and the integration of mitigation and adaptation efforts.
