Carbon Neutral Action Report School District No. 68 (Nanaimo-Ladysmith)

Executive Summary

School District #68 (Nanaimo-Ladysmith) has been actively pursuing energy use reduction in the form of various projects. For example, lighting retrofits have been a fixed AFG budget item for the past 10 years. In more recent years that budget has been supplemented by various incentive grants from BC Hydro and PSECA thus enabling the number of project completions to accelerate. Prior to 2008 there have been other initiatives completed such as Variable Speed Drives on large HVAC units and motion sensors for lighting controls in gyms that have extended the power use reduction.

In 2008 there have been other initiatives started such as computerized field irrigation control tied into school based weather station for real time condition assessment and a phase 1 assessment and re-commissioning of DDC systems and HVAC units. Retirement of older fleet vehicles along with an anti-idling program was initiated and are looking ahead in 2009 to incorporate a software tool to better manage fleet maintenance and vehicle use tracking.

2009 will also see the completion of an HVAC upgrade project at an elementary school which will include the condensing boiler/conventional boiler system. This will be a testing project for design standard for boiler upgrade/replacement which is now an annual AFG budget item with a long term multi-year plan in place. Bus driver training will be completed which will supplement the anti-idling program. Green purchasing practices are now in effect and the district has been able to reduce the number of different cleaning products down to 2 types - all of which are green seal. Other non-cleaning product green type purchasing practices are also in effect and continue to expand the product lines in this direction.

Behavioural initiatives are on-going with programs targeted at school students and staff members and plans to extend this to maintenance and other staff are in the works. Computer server reduction is another project to be initiated with possibilities of fairly major reduction in IT hardware.

Part 1: Actions Taken to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions in 2008

Overview:

The most constant of all initiatives is the on-going lighting retrofit projects and in 2008 there were 4 elementary schools completed. Also, planning took place for 2 more elementary schools and a secondary school gym.

Fleet conservation measures included anti-idling education by way of instruction and stickers, anti-particulate mufflers and crankcase ventilation kits installed. Planning for bus pass payroll deduction to encourage public transportation use.

Purchasing policy extended to include footprint reduction use of copy paper by including in the RFP for replacement of the copier and printer fleet with equipment with document management capabilities. Increase in collaboration with purchasing department regarding sustainable products. Eco friendly paints also included.

Various HVAC projects include Design for HVAC upgrade that includes upgrade to condensing boilers. This will realize a significant carbon footprint reduction. Installation of VFD's as part of an on-going initiative and DDC system re-commissioning revealing systems that could be shut off more often including Christmas break and spring break shutdowns.

Awareness programs included the planning for the Energy Ambassadors program in 2 secondary schools. The completion of composting program at all secondary schools in the district.

Overview:

Lighting retrofits will continue into the future until all schools and other facilities have been completed. Along with that would be the HVAC upgrade and boiler replacement upgrade project completion at one elementary school. Planning of boiler replacement at an elementary school - part of an on-going project. Mechanical system re-commissioning are also part of the long term plans.

Plans for increased awareness for bus drivers for fleet fuel reduction which will be done through on-going training. And, perform an audit of the existing fleet to determine less efficient vehicles and initiate a long term replacement plan. Plan in place to increase bio-fuel use and the start-up of the fleet maintenance management and vehicle use tracking software program.

On the technology side the main focus will be Server Virtualization
