C. Briefly describe the top three actions taken by your organization in 2019 to reduce GHG emissions and/or improve sustainability from its operations:

Action

1. Committee meetings were, whenever possible, held virtually via Zoom rather than having committee members drive into town.

2. Rather than fly our new Governor (our Board is recruited from all across the Province) down to Vancouver for their orientation, we provided an all-day orientation via Zoom instead.

3. We switched as many of our grantees over to Electronic Fund Transfer payments as possible, drastically reducing our need to gather signatories, send couriers, and send mail.

D. Briefly describe plans your organization has for continuing to reduce your GHG emissions in future years:

Reduced travel, more digital meetings. Reducing paper consumption by increasingly switching to digital files. Switching to DocuSign so that even more of our paperwork can be done online.

E. Describe any actions your organization took during 2019 to strengthen its ability to manage the likely effects of climate change in the coming years and decades (e.g., have assessed whether increased frequency of extreme weather events and/or long-term changes in climate will affect your organization's infrastructure, its employees and/or its clients.)

Our operations will remain largely unaffected by anything except the most catastrophic events, as most of our staff can work from home if needed and we have our data backed up in numerous locations across the country, so in the event of a serious incident it would not be too difficult for us to return to work (relatively speaking). We will likely be taking even more steps towards a cloud-based solution in the near future. Even during the COVID-19 crisis, our work experienced minimal interruption.

Interestingly, the work of our grantees often relates directly to climate change. Many of the projects we fund directly contribute to preparing communities across BC for climate change
