Declaration statement: This PSO Climate Change Accountability Report for the period January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022 summarizes our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions profile, the total offsets to reach net-zero emissions, the actions we have taken in 2022 to minimize our GHG emissions, and our plans to continue reducing emissions in 2023 and beyond.

Emission Reductions: Actions & Plans

A. Stationary Sources (e.g. buildings, power generation)

LABC does not own any buildings or manage retrofits.

The organization continues to take steps to reduce power generation where possible, by taking steps such as using motion sensor controlled lights in meeting rooms, notifying building management of water leaks to reduce water waste and purchasing energy efficient appliances and equipment. Also, LABC has policies and procedures in place to ensure environmentally sound methods of disposal of furniture and equipment through recycling and reuse.

B. Mobile Sources (e.g. fleet vehicles, off-road/portable equipment)

LABC does not have any organizational fleet vehicles, or off-road portable equipment.

C. Paper Consumption

LABC continues to use only recycled paper and has implemented the use of cloud-based file management to reduce the use of paper throughout the organization.
