Emission Reductions: Actions & Plans

Briefly describe to three actions undertaken by the district in 2023/2024 to reduce GHG emissions and/or improve sustainability from operations.

A. Stationary Sources (e.g. buildings, power generation)

- 1. Strategy
 - a. Upgraded 50% of NESS from fluorescent lighting to LED; plans are to continue to 100% for 24/25 school year.
 - b. Commissioned HVAC tech company to balance and check components for heating for all four schools to ensure more efficient operations during the heating season.
 - c. Replacement of HVAC fans at NESS to units that are more efficient

B. Mobile Sources (e.g. fleet vehicles, off-road/portable equipment)

Regular maintenance to ensure buses and white fleet are operating as efficient as possible.

Reduce daily bus runs where possible to minimize number of trips per week.

C. Paper Consumption

Formation of a more awareness notices on utilization of paper and more frequent reports from photocopier provider on paper consumption.
