This year's symposium will take place in conjunction with the **QUEST** (Quality Urban Energy Systems of Tomorrow) conference and tradeshow in Vancouver.

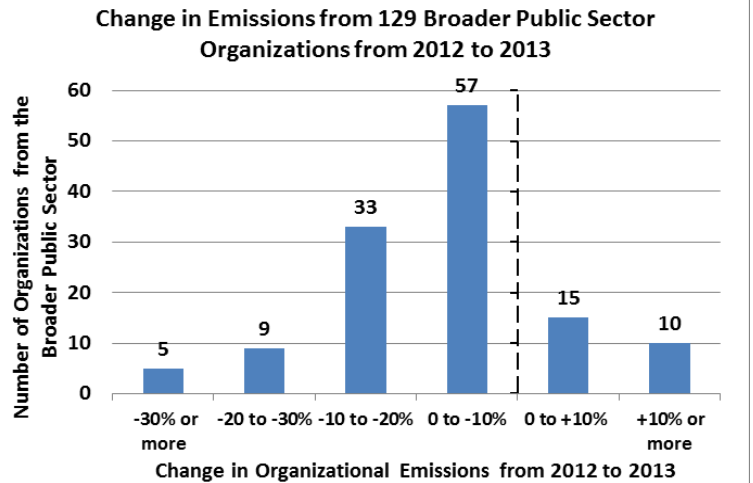
