Look Mom! No Emissions!

In early 2020, the CleanBC GoElectric School Bus Program pilot offered participating school districts an

opportunity to leverage funding to replace aging diesel school buses. Fuel efficient driving techniques and more efficient bus route design has already contributed to a significant drop in fuel consumption – up to 30%.

"Electric school buses are the natural next step to continue on the path towards zero GHGs for the future of the children we serve," Robyn Stephenson, Manager of Transportation Services at School District #22



in Vernon. Recognizing the cost-saving and environmental benefits, the district will be integrating two electric buses into service next year.

The inaugural uptake for the program exceeded expectations, with 13 school districts ordering a total of 18 electric school buses.
