Instructions:

- Powers or duties cannot be referred to a higher authority decision maker unless that higher authority decision maker is specified in the delegation column. If no other higher authority decision maker is listed then the power or duty must go to the chief forester.
- If a section of the *Forest Act* or regulations is not noted in the table, then the power or duty defaults to the chief forester.
- As per the *Forest Act*, no subdelegation is permitted.

A reference to a delegate in the table below includes a person acting for the delegate.
