Re: Designation of Natural Resource Officers under the *Natural Resource Compliance Act* – Ministry of Forests

Designation of natural resource officers

1. Under section 2 (1) of the *Natural Resource Compliance Act*, I designate the following class of persons employed by the Compliance and Enforcement Branch, Ministry of Forests, identified in the list below as “natural resource officers”:
 - (a) Excluded Managers
 - (b) Licensed Science Officers
 - (c) Scientific Technical Officers
 - (d) Biologists

A reference above to a person by class includes a person acting in the position.

Limitations on natural resource officers’ powers and duties

2. Pursuant to section 2 (2) of the *Natural Resource Compliance Act*, natural resource officers designated in section 1 of this memorandum have the following limitations for the enactments listed in the table below:
