DEFINITIONS

“Final Agreement” means the final agreements between each Te'mexw Member First Nation, Canada, and British Columbia;

“Parties” means each of the Te'mexw Member First Nations, Canada, and British Columbia and
“Party” means any one of them;

“Te'mexw Member First Nation” means any of the five collectivities of a Te'mexw Member First Nation People;

“Te'mexw Member First Nation People” means those individuals who are eligible to be enrolled under the Final Agreement in accordance with the Eligibility and Enrolment Chapter.

AMENDMENT

1. Except for any provision of the Final Agreement that provides that an amendment requires the consent of only a Te'mexw Member First Nation and either Canada or British Columbia, any amendments to the Final Agreement will require the consent of all three Parties.
2. Where all Parties agree that an amendment to the Final Agreement is required, the Parties will proceed as soon as practicable to agree on the wording of the amendment.
3. Canada will give consent to an amendment to the Final Agreement by order of the Governor-in-Council.
4. British Columbia will give consent to an amendment to the Final Agreement by passing a resolution of the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia.
5. The Te'mexw Member First Nation will give consent to an amendment to the Final Agreement by a vote in favour of ratifying the amendment by a majority of the eligible voters of the affected Te'mexw Member First Nation who are eligible to be enrolled in the Te'mexw Member First Nation.
6. The Parties will take the necessary steps to implement an amendment to the Final Agreement as soon as possible after the amendment has been ratified by all Parties.
