

AMENDMENT #1

Pursuant to paragraph 13 of the *Forestry Agreement*, dated December 1, 2006, between the Blueberry River First Nations and the Government of British Columbia, the Parties agree to amend the Forestry Agreement, as set out below:

(1) On the coming into effect of the Final Agreement between the Blueberry River First Nations and the Government of British Columbia, paragraph 16 is deleted and replaced with the following:

16 (a) This agreement will take effect on the date on which the last party has executed it and will terminate on the earliest of any of the following events:


- (i) five years from the date this Agreement is executed;
- (ii) the mutual agreement of the Parties; or
- (iii) upon 90 days written notice by either of the Parties.

16 (b) Prior to this Agreement terminating in accordance with section 16.a, and if
(i) the terms and conditions of this Agreement are being met, and
(ii) the Final Agreement between British Columbia and the Blueberry River First Nations is in effect,
the Government of British Columbia and the Blueberry River First Nations will seek the necessary authorities and approvals to renew this Agreement.


16 (c) Any subsequent Forestry Agreement between the Parties may provide for an opportunity to acquire a Forest Tenure or other benefits that are agreed to by the Parties.

(2) Except as modified by this amending agreement, the agreement remains in full force and effect.
