



Amendment to the Short Term Mountain Pine Beetle Agreement (the Agreement) between the Burns Lake Band and the Government of British Columbia dated December 1, 2006.

**The Burns Lake Band and the Government of British Columbia hereby agree to the following amendments of the Agreement:**

Section 2 to read as: After execution of this Agreement by the Parties, the Minister of Forests and Range (the "Minister") will invite the Burns Lake Band to apply for a non-replaceable forest licence under section 47.3 of the *Forest Act* to harvest a total of up to 208,500 cubic meters over a five year term in the Lakes Timber Supply Area within the area identified as Exhibit A identified in the new Appendix A, as per attached.

Section 5 to read as: Any invitation will be subject to a condition that prior to making an application for the Licence, the Burns Lake Band will contact the Ministry of Forests and Range and the Parties will work co-operatively to identify an operation area in the Lakes Timber Supply Area within the area identified as Exhibit A identified in the new Appendix A, as per attached.

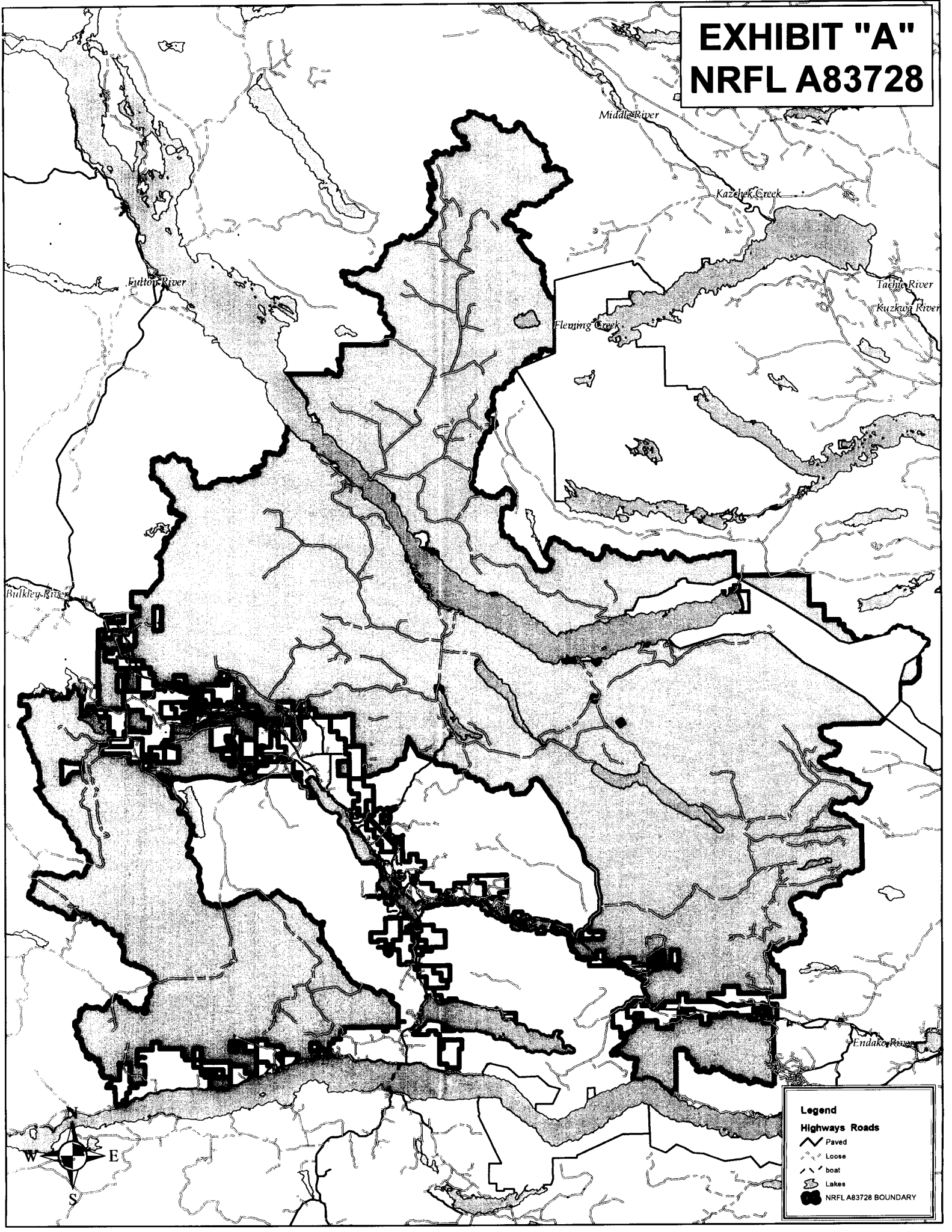
