AMENDING AGREEMENT

This Agreement is dated for reference the 27th day of February, 2014 (the "Reference Date")

BETWEEN:

Tk'emlups te Secwépemc and Skeetchestn Indian Band
(hereinafter the Stk'emlúpsemc te Secwépemc Nation),

Adams Lake Indian Band, Neskonlith Indian Band and Splatsin First Nation
(hereinafter the Sexqeltkemc te Secwépemc Nation or 'Lakes Division'),

Simpew First Nation and Shuswap Indian Band

("Secwépemc")

AND:

Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of British Columbia, as represented by the Minister of Aboriginal Relations and Reconciliation

("Province")

(each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties")

WHEREAS:

- A. The Parties wish to add the Shuswap Indian Band as a party to the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement entered on April 10, 2013.
- B. Section 13 of the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement sets out an amendment process for adding other Secwépeme communities to the Agreement and making other amendments to the Agreement.
- C. The Parties wish to amend the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement to provide for the withdrawal of Secwépeme communities from the Agreement.

THEREFORE the Secwépeme and the Province agree as follows.

- 1. The Parties have completed the amendment process set out in section 13 of the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement.
- 2. By signing this Amending Agreement, the Parties agree to amend the Secwépemc Reconciliation Framework Agreement as follows on and after the Reference Date:

- a. The Shuswap Indian Band will be added as a party to the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement;
- b. Appendix A, titled Secwépeme Territories, of the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement, will be replaced with the map attached at Appendix A to this Amending Agreement which includes the traditional territory of the Shuswap Indian Band:
- c. The definition of "Secwépeme Traditional Territories" or "Territories" in the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement will be replaced with:
 - "Secwépeme Traditional Territories" or "Territories" means the asserted traditional territories of the Secwépeme which are illustrated as a single boundary for the purposes of this Agreement on the map attached in the Amending Agreement.
- d. Section 15 Term and Termination of the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement will be amended by adding a new section 15.10 that states "The withdrawal of a Secwépeme community from this Agreement does not terminate this Agreement as between the remaining Secwépeme and the Province."; and
- e. The words "Splats'in Indian Band" in the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement will be replaced with "Splatsin First Nation."
- 3. This Amending Agreement takes effect on the Reference Date.
- 4. This Amending Agreement may be signed in counterparts and exchanged by electronic means of transmission.
- 5. A participating First Nation will have until 5 pm on February 19, 2014 to provide its counterpart to the Province.
- 6. If any counterpart has not been provided to the Province by 5pm February 19, 2014, that First Nation is no longer a participating First Nation under this Amending Agreement and is deemed to have withdrawn from this Amending Agreement and the Secwépeme Reconciliation Framework Agreement at midnight on February 19, 2014.
