Engagement Stats for CEF Phase 2 Engagement

- 103 day consultation period (4 April to 15 July 2016)
- Over 20 meetings and information sessions
- Approximately 250 NRS ministry staff participants for the provincial Live Meeting
- 80 participants at three public workshops
 - workshop 1 - 21 participants
 - workshop 2 - 23 participants
 - workshop 3 - 36 participants
- Cumulative effects framework public Internet site
 - webpages viewed 4,750 times
 - 2.9 minutes spent on each engagement webpage
 - 1,904 downloads of engagement documents
- Cumulative effects framework internal staff Intranet site
 - webpages viewed 647 times
 - 2.4 minutes spent on each engagement webpage
- 19 written submissions received
 - 13 (68%) from external stakeholders
 - 4 (21%) from First Nations communities or organizations
 - 2 (11%) from internal staff
- Comments received from
 - 29 NRS stakeholders
 - 19 provincial ministry organizations
 - 9 environmental non-government organizations
 - 6 First Nations communities or organizations
 - 2 university organizations
 - 2 federal government organizations
 - 1 regional government
- 1,112 detailed comments received
 - 700 (63%) from external stakeholders
 - 107 (10%) from First Nations communities or organizations
 - 305 (27%) from internal staff
