

Pesticide Use Record: Agricultural Operators and Essential Services

This form is for use only by agricultural operators and essential services using second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides (SGARs). For licensees using SGARs, use the alternate Licensee form available on the Ministry website.

Under a Minister's Order, effective July 21, 2021, there are new record requirements for all authorized uses of SGARs (rodenticides containing the active ingredient brodifacoum, bromadiolone, or difethialone). Visit www.gov.bc.ca/RodentIPM to learn more.

This pesticide use record must be completed for every SGAR that is used for each treatment location and day of use. It does not have to be submitted to the ministry unless requested.

Pesticide use records must be kept for a period of three (3) years following the pesticide use and must be made available to the ministry upon request. Please note that while a record of each SGAR use is required, the use of this specific form is voluntary and many applicators elect to use their own systems to record the required information.
