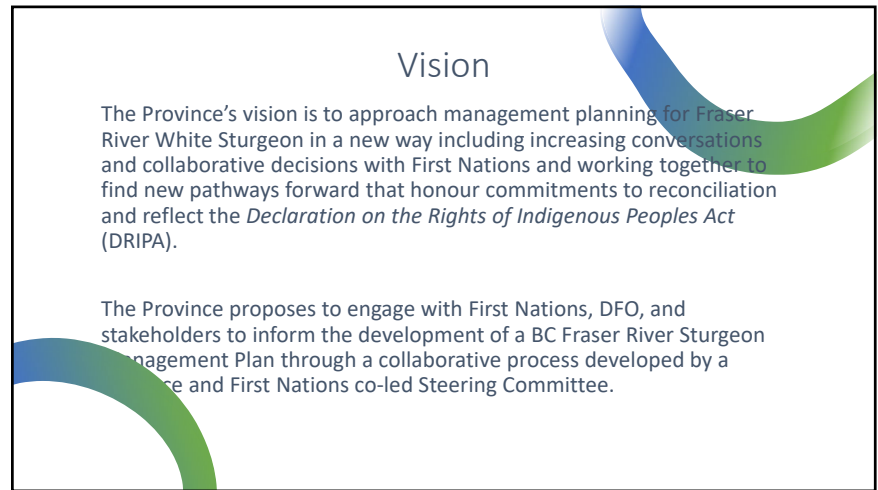


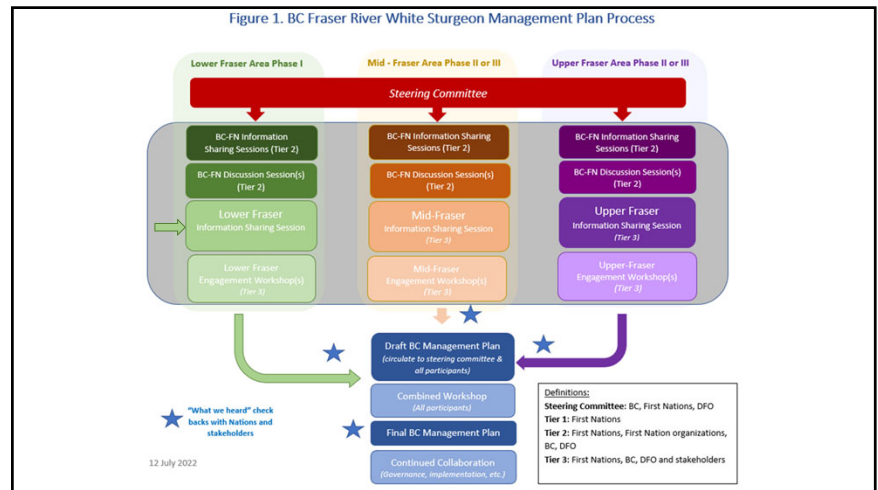



Participation

-  The **Steering Committee** is an agile team that provides guidance on the process used to develop a BC Fraser River Sturgeon Management Plan by providing direction, oversight, and advice throughout the project. Steering committee members link participants to the process but do not speak for participants.
-  **Tier 1** sessions provide First Nations rights-holders and organizations time to independently discuss the management planning process and/or sessions.
-  **Tier 2** sessions will support inter-governmental discussions and decisions between First Nations, the Province of BC, and DFO. These sessions will provide opportunities to share perspectives, share data, contribute knowledge, share views and opinions, and review components of the document.
-  **Tier 3** sessions will provide opportunities for all interested parties to share their perspectives, learn about other perspectives, contribute their opinions and review products. Tier 3 includes all external stakeholders in addition to the Tier 2 members (i.e., First Nations, BC and DFO).
