- Intuitive, easy to use interface




Report-a-Weed Mobile App


Features

- Ability to search for plants by Latin name, Common name, or Flower Colour
- Scroll through images of plants of the same flower colour
- Add photograph to report



Features

- Create reports, even when off-line! Click submit and the report will be sent as soon as you are back in cell coverage
- If you don't know the plant species you want to report, select the 'Unknown' option.



Step 1 – only necessary once

The app uses the GPS in your phone to send the exact location in the report. If you choose 'Don't Allow', then there will be no Lat/Longs submitted with your report (that makes it hard to find! ☺)








Step 1 – Choose plant

- Choose the plant you want to report.
 - Alphabetically using Latin name or Common name, or flower colour




Step 2 – Start Report

- Once you find and select your plant, click 'Report This Weed'
- From this screen, you can also slide the image to scroll through plants of the same colour



Step 3 – Enter specifics

- Use the slider to select the approximate square footage of the infestation
- Enter your name and/or phone, email contact (only needs to be done once)
- If you like, you can add a comment



Step 3a – Optional comment

If you like, you can add a comment




Step 3b – Optional photo

You can take a picture and add it to your submission; or you may choose an existing photo




Step 4 – Send

- You're done!




Other Features
