## Caribou Recovery Program Strategy

**Vision:** Resilient ecosystems and thriving caribou populations.

Resilient ecosystems support thriving caribou populations and sustain Indigenous rights and the well-being of all British Columbians.

### Goals

Four goals drive Program actions:

**Goal 1: Caribou Recovery**

Stabilization and recovery of Threatened caribou herds through a prioritized approach.

**Goal 2: Inclusive Stewardship**

Shared responsibility for caribou recovery.

**Goal 3: Durable Provincial Program**

Accountability and transparency support successful caribou recovery implementation.

**Goal 4: Well-Informed Decisions**

Multiple knowledge pathways inform caribou recovery and ecosystem health decisions.

### Objectives

***Caribou Recovery:***

- Prioritize immediate recovery actions on existing herds with the greatest likelihood of being recovered
- Increase quantity and quality of caribou habitat to sustain herd recovery into the long term
- Stabilize and grow herd populations
- Manage adaptively

***Inclusive Stewardship:***

- Meaningful engagement on caribou recovery
- Interested First Nations are partners in the delivery of the program
- Alignment with other provincial and federal government initiatives with shared priorities

- Effective collaboration with stewardship partners who share an interest in the recovery of caribou

***Durable Provincial Program:***

- A coordinated and consistent provincial-scale program
- Confirmed strategic and operational direction for caribou recovery
- Broader public understanding of the status of caribou and requirements to help their populations recover

***Well Informed Decisions:***

- Improved knowledge to support caribou recovery decisions
- Accessible data and information
- Comprehensive decision support in coordination with partners
