Re: Non-compliance Advisory Letter, Permit 7581, Egmont

On March 7, 2018, Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy, Environmental Protection Division staff conducted an office review inspection of the Egmont Fish Plant located at 6719 Maple Road, Egmont, BC, Fish Processing Plant with authorization number 7581 under the *Environmental Management Act*. Ministry staff spoke with Mr. Hansen over the phone to conduct this inspection.

This Advisory, the alleged violations and the circumstances to which it refers will form part of the compliance history of Egmont Fish Plant, and will be taken into account in the event of future non-compliance.

Please note that this authorization is considered to be out of compliance until such a time as it can be confirmed to meet the authorization requirements.

Inspection Details:

Requirement Description:	3. MONITORING AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, 3.2. Reporting 3.2: Maintain data of analyses and flow measurements for inspection and submit the data, suitably tabulated, to the Regional Manager, Environmental Protection, for the previous calendar year. All reports shall be submitted within 31 days of the end of each calendar year. Each data submission shall include a statement outlining the number of reported values that were outside the permit limits. Clearly identify the dates of these occurrences in the data submission, include an explanation as to the cause of each occurrence and provide a description of the measures taken to rectify the situation. Should all submitted values be within the permit limits, a statement to that effect shall be included.
Details/Findings:	On March 7, 2018, Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy (ENV), Environmental Protection Division staff, conducted an office review inspection of the Egmont Fish Plant's (Facility) Permit 7581 authorized under the <i>Environmental Management Act</i> (EMA). The permittee has failed to submit any effluent flow data as required by the Permit within 31 days of the end of the calendar year for 2017.
Compliance:	Out

Actions to be taken:	<p>Please be advised that if no fish processing effluent has been discharged throughout the year, then zero flow is required to be submitted in order to maintain compliance.
