Re: Rescinding of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) Plan

Dear Tharaka Abilash Prathap:

As per your letter of October 9, 2025, Telus Communications Inc. will not be making any amendments to your current Extended Producer Responsibility Plan, approved under the Recycling Regulation, *Environmental Management Act*. Further, you indicated in your letter that Telus intends to join the Electronic Products Recycling Association (EPRA) plan, and begin remitting for October of 2025. You requested that the Telus plan be rescinded effective October 1, 2025.

I notified you via email that in response to this request, I intended to rescind the Telus EPR plan.

By way of this letter, I hereby rescind Telus Communications Inc's approved EPR plan under Section 6.1 of the Recycling Regulation, effective October 1, 2025.

Please be aware that Telus will still be required to complete the annual reporting requirements under your plan until the date of rescinding, and you may wish to coordinate this activity with EPRA, if necessary.

If you disagree with this decision, Division 2 of Part 8 of the *Environmental Management Act* provides for appeal of my decision to the Environmental Appeal Board (EAB). In accordance with the *Act* and with the Environmental Appeal Board Procedures regulation, the EAB must receive notice of the appeal no later than 30 days after the date you receive this decision.
