Re: Rescinding of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) Plan

Dear Laura Selanders:

As per your letter of July 15th, 2024, the Canadian Electrical Stewardship Association (CESA) will amalgamate their business with the Electronic Products Recycling Association (EPRA), effective October 1, 2024. You requested that the CESA EPR plan be rescinded effective September 30, 2024. On September 9, 2024, I notified you that in response to this request, I intended to rescind your EPR plan effective September 30, 2024.

By way of this letter, I rescind CESA's approved plan under Section 6.1 of the Recycling Regulation, effective end of day September 30, 2024.

Please be aware that CESA will still be required to complete the annual reporting requirements under your plan until the date of rescinding, and you may wish to coordinate this activity with EPRA, if necessary.

If you disagree with this decision, Division 2 of Part 8 of the *Environmental Management Act* provides for appeal of my decision to the Environmental Appeal Board (EAB). In accordance with the *Act* and with the Environmental Appeal Board Procedures regulation, the EAB must receive notice of the appeal no later than 30 days after the date you receive this decision.
