

SUMMARY: FILE REVIEW

Of the Death of a Child in the Care of the Director in 2018

Circumstances of the Fatality

The review examined the case files of an Indigenous child in the care of the director who died from a health issue. The director was providing services to the child in care in relation to their various health needs.

Findings

The child's health needs required ongoing and intensive services and support. A comprehensive care team that included medical professionals, family members, and community support was in place to address the child's needs. A thorough and current Care Plan was established to inform planning for the child and the resources required to meet the child's high medical needs. The child's death was determined to be the result of natural causes.

Actions

The findings of the file review did not identify areas that required any actions.

The review was completed in August 2019.
