

## **Summary: Child and Family Practice Review of a Critical Injury of a Child Known to the Director in 2022**

### Circumstances of the Critical Injury

The review examined the services provided to an Indigenous child who was critically injured. The child and their family received services at the time of the critical injury.

### Findings

The director attended the home in a timely way and saw the child. A collateral check was completed. Child protection reports were concluded following the initial assessment and concerns regarding a specific issue were not discussed. Practices related to a child safety issue were not reviewed.

Prior to the review being finalized, staff received training on documentation and assessment. A process to discuss complex circumstances was initiated. Training regarding a specific issue was provided.

### Actions

The involved Indigenous Child and Family Services Agency leadership and the Quality Assurance team developed an action plan to provide learning sessions about assessment procedures.

**The review was completed in November 2023. The above action plan is due for full implementation in January 2024.**
