

## **Summary: Child and Family Practice Review of the Death of a Child in the Care of the Director in 2022**

### Circumstances of the Fatality

The review examined the services provided to an Indigenous child who died. The child and their family received guardianship services at the time of the death.

### Findings

The ministry addressed the needs of the child while they were initially in the care of the director and supported the parent to address concerns. The child then returned to their parent under a legal order. When new safety concerns arose, the child was brought back into the care of the director. The practitioner met with the child and their care team frequently to address their needs. Services were provided to the child to address a specific issue. The child's Indigenous community was involved in planning for the child.

### Actions

No actions were required to address the findings of the review.
