

## **Summary: Child and Family Practice Review of the Death of a Youth in the Care of the Director in 2022**

### Circumstances of the Fatality

The review examined the services provided to an Indigenous youth who died. The youth was receiving guardianship services at the time of the death.

### Findings

The director assessed and planned for the youth's needs, with particular attention paid to their health and permanency. The guardianship worker arranged frequent care meetings and plans were completed to support the youth inclusive of their presenting concerns.

Prior to the review being finalized, staff at the Indigenous Child and Family Service (ICFS) Agency were provided with training on required assessments and reports, as well as file documentation. The ICFS Agency leadership also reviewed the report with staff with a focus on learning.

### Actions

No actions were required to address the findings of this review.
