

Summary: Child and Family Practice Review of the Death of a Child in the Care of the Director in 2022

Circumstances of the Fatality

The review examined the services provided to an Indigenous child who died. The child and their family were receiving services at the time of the death.

Findings

The child's relational and cultural permanency was supported through regular contact and collaboration with the child's parents and the involved Indigenous communities. The director engaged regularly with the child's care team and saw the child often. Leadership was updated on the child's circumstances and participated in planning to address the child's needs.

Actions

No actions were required to address the findings of the review.

The review was completed in March 2024.
