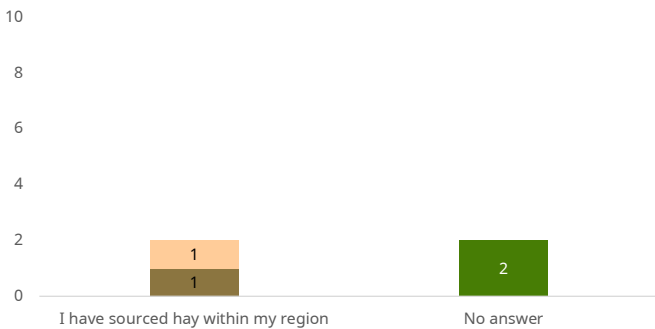

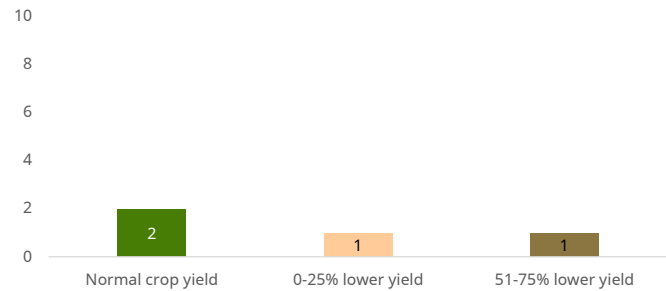
How would you describe your irrigation water supply for the forage crops?



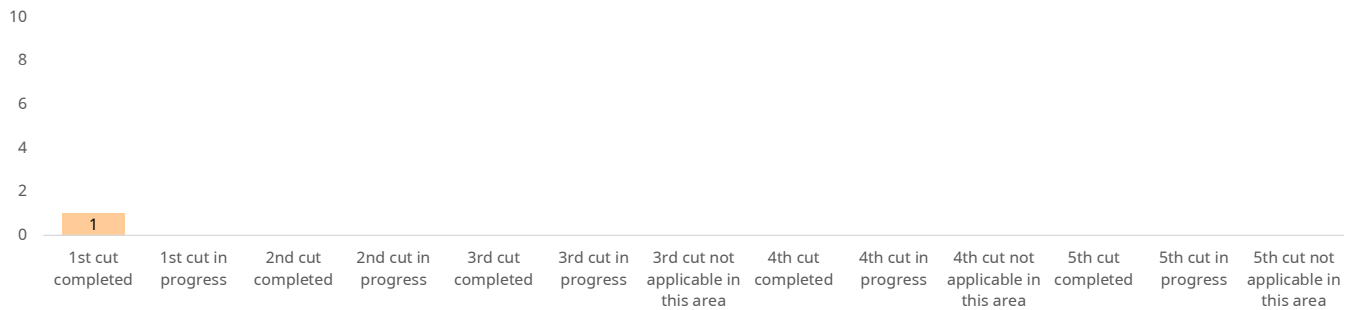

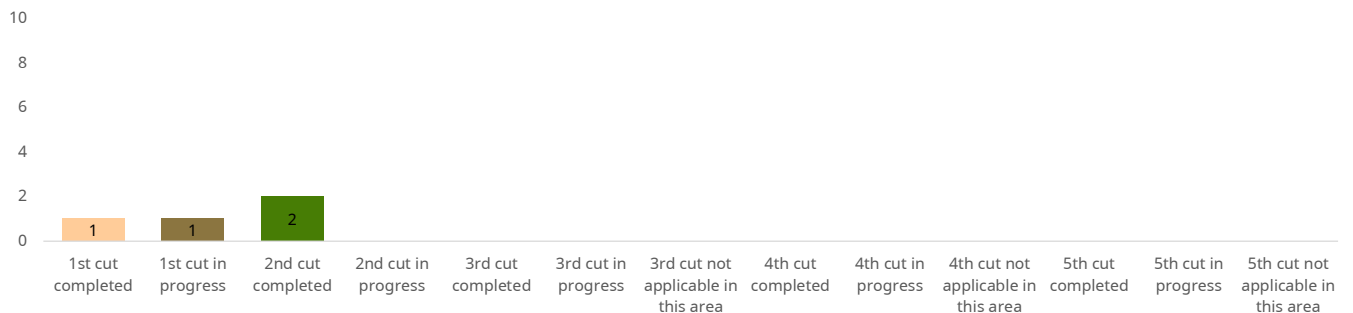
