Farmers and Ranchers throughout the province dealt with numerous challenges in 2017 including winter freeze, excessive moisture, and wildfires that caused market volatility and increased input costs.. The Ministry of Agriculture will be holding information sessions across the province starting at the end of January 2018 to provide information on the BC AgriStability Enhancement Program that will provide a benefit if your operation has suffered an income decline.
