Your Annual Fisheries Production Schedule (AFPS) is **due February 15, 2021** for:

Location	Provincial Licence(s)	Federal Registration(s)

It is a legal requirement under the Fish and Seafood Act for all B.C. seafood producers to provide annual reports on their seafood production to the Ministry of Agriculture. Data from all B.C. seafood processors, receivers, vendors and seafood marketers are combined and used for:

- Economic analyses
- Program development
- Sector funding decisions
- International fisheries treaty negotiations

You must complete an AFPS ([xlsx](#)) for each operation location.

- Report all B.C. seafood sold or remaining in inventory in its final form.

The Ministry of Agriculture ensures the confidentiality of your submissions. Data is combined across three or more companies for reporting; data from individual forms and companies will not be released or published.
