**SUBMIT YOUR ANNUAL FISHERIES PRODUCTION SCHEDULE (AFPS) BY **January 30, 2026****

All B.C. fish receivers are required to provide the Ministry of Agriculture & Food with a report on their seafood sales under the *Fish and Seafood Act*. Data from all receivers, processors, vendors, and seafood marketers are combined and used for:

- Economic analyses
- Program and policy development
- Sector funding decisions
- International fisheries treaty negotiations

You must complete an AFPS for each operation location. Report all B.C. seafood sold or remaining in inventory in its final form.

**As per [Ministerial Order M10/2025](#), paper forms, PDFS, or images will not be accepted.**

**Before You Fill Out the Web Form**

- Ensure you have a **BASIC** BCeID. If you don't already have one, you can obtain one in just a few minutes by following these [instructions](#).
- You may use either a **basic BCeID** or an **EXISTING business BCeID** to access the form. **Do not register for a new business BCeID**, as this process can take weeks and will delay your submission. If you don't already have a business BCeID, simply register for a basic BCeID.
