**ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (EMS)**

- C**omplete a pre-work with your supervisor and understand your role.
- H**ave a project plan and map available and know your location at all times.
- K**now which Environmental Field Procedure (EFP) cards apply to you, review them and have them available.
- B**e prepared for environmental emergencies and know location of response equipment (spill kits, fire equipment).

**STOP WORK AND CONTACT YOUR SUPERVISOR IF:**

<p>You're uncertain of the project plan, your responsibilities or hazardous/ sensitive areas.</p>	<p>You observe unfavourable conditions that could cause environmental damage.</p>
<p>A previously unidentified resource feature is found.</p>	<p>Species at risk sightings.</p>
<p>Hazardous material spills, uncontrolled fires or landslides occur.</p>	<p>Any safety hazards, close calls/ near misses or accidents that occur.</p>
