

Species of Management Concern in BCTS Seaward-tlasta Business Area



Stop work and contact your project supervisor if any of these features are found during harvesting/road building operations. Take photos if camera available and immediately contact the BCTS Representative.

Large stick nests (couple of feet in diameter), ~2/3 up dominant trees, near bole of tree



Any signs of egg fragments on ground, feather down, bones, whitewash under nest site or separate 'plucking'



Any signs of a hawk, chicks or calls from raptors



Large stick nests (rookeries) found near blocks



Active bear or wolf dens (bedded down, signs of debris clearing at entrance of den, fir, bear/wolf around den)
