This report provides an overview of British Columbia's forest product exports and markets. In 2022, forest product exports made up 24% of B.C.'s total commodity export value.

Starting with the March report in 2023, Macau is included in the exports to China. The historical export data from 2013 to 2022 has also been updated.









Figure 3: Softwood Lumber Export Value \$1.0 \$8 \$0.9 \$7 Monthly Value (lines), \$ billions \$0.8 \$6 \$0.7 (bars), \$ bil \$5 \$0.6 \$0.5 \$0.4 TD Value \$0.3 \$0.2 \$1 \$0.1 Jan Feb Mar Apr May Jun Jul Aug Sep Oct Nov Dec 2022 YTD ___ _ 2022 Monthly ••••• 2023 Monthly








