> Starting with the March report in 2023, Macau is included in the exports to China. The historical export data from 2013 to 2022 has also been updated.








Figure 3: Softwood Lumber Export Value













Figure 4: Softwood Lumber Export Value -12-Month Moving Sum




Figure 13: Exchange Rate US\$/C\$





Figure 16: Pulp Export Quantity

















Figure 19: Log Export Quantity-
