

LEXIS 2.8.1 BUG FIXES for Industry Users

(Effective March 24 2017)

CREATING/EDITING EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS:

Applicant Contact info - Corrected a couple of bugs so LEXIS will now accurately display the entered applicant/owner/client info on advertising list and permits, including client location info as initially selected on the original application.

Coast Species/Grade/End Use Combination Update – We removed an extraneous filter in the schema code that was restricting allowable combinations and allowed a more accurate alignment to display the federal codes as well e.g. Alder/Maple/Sawlog. See attached revised Coast Species and Sort Code Label list..

PERMIT PROCESSING:

Creation and storage of an online permit – removed a bug that sometimes duplicated a permit in the PDF.

Updates to Permits in Active status – Removed a bug that wouldn't allow industry or staff to delete and correct a line of scale in their permit application.

Updates to Permits in Complete status – Removed a bug that wouldn't allow industry to add documents to their permit.

SEARCHES:

Internal: *Update to Application Review* – removed a bug that restricted the ability to sort the data by Region. *Update to Application Search* – removed a bug that allowed some applications to display more than once.

GENERAL:

Updated BC log and ministry name - on the LEXIS application (but not the reports)
