

TO ALL EXPORTERS, LOG BROKERS and LOG BUYERS

This notice refers to the process of exempting and permitting all unmanufactured timber for export.

In our commitment to provide complete and timely service, the following schedule outlines the maximum number of business days that may be required to process the various export approvals/permits. While this has been general practice for years, some components have been added to assist you.

- 1 For a Ministerial Order Exemption to Export Unmanufactured Timber Products, please allow **3** business days after the deadline for receipt of offers.

- 2 For a Permit to Export Unmanufactured Timber Products (FS34), please allow **10** business days after receipt of the complete Application for Permit to Export Unmanufactured Timber Products (FS38) package. This includes 'shut-out' permits.

- 3 Where there has been a change of consignee after permitting, please allow **5** business days for the processing of a replacement permit.

Every effort will continue to be made to process these applications as soon as received.
