## **Background**

On February 4, 2022, the Department of Commerce (Commerce) published the *Preliminary Results* of this administrative review.<sup>1</sup> The current deadline for the final results of this review is June 6, 2022.

## **Extension of Time Limits for the Final Results**

Section 751(a)(3)(A) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (the Act), and 19 CFR 351.213(h)(1) require that Commerce complete the final results of a countervailing duty administrative review within 120 days after the date of publication of the preliminary results of review. If it is not practicable to complete the review within that time period, section 751(a)(3)(A) of the Act and 19 CFR 351.213(h)(2) allow Commerce to extend the time limit for the final results to a maximum of 180 days after the date of publication of the preliminary results.

We determine that it is not practicable to complete the final results of this review by the current deadline of June 6, 2022. We require additional time to evaluate the stumpage and non-

stumpage arguments presented in case and rebuttal briefs submitted on the record by several interested parties to this administrative review. Therefore, we recommend extending the time limit for issuing the final results of this review to 180 days after the date of publication of the *Preliminary Results*, until August 3, 2022, in accordance with section 751(a)(3)(A) of the Act and 19 CFR 351.213(h)(2).
