This release includes updates for interior policy, effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, as well as bug fixes and minor enhancements.

## **Interior Appraisal Updates**

- Sampling Error % (on ECAS63) Upper Limit has been raised from 100.0 to 999.9.
- Cultural Burning and Root Disease Control
  - Two new fields have been added to ECAS63:
    - Is Cultural Burning required? (Y/N)
    - Cultural Burning Cost (\$/m³)
  - Attachments (ECAS70) Options have been added for Cultural Burning and Root Disease Control
  - XML & Save Validations have been added for Cultural Burning as it is a mandatory field, and when required a Cost needs to be entered.
  - Additionally Submit Validations have been added for the Attachments. When Cultural Burning or Root Disease Control are required the corresponding attachments are needed.
- Enhanced Silviculture Plan Codes Two new codes have been added:
  - LND Lakes TSA of Nadina District (FSP 651)
  - o NRD Stuart Nechako NRD portion of the Prince George TSA (FSP 999)

## **Coast Appraisal Updates**

- Coast PHARM Risk Assessment screen (ECAS48) will be displayed without error for Appraisals with multiple Timber Marks
- Coast Appraisals with an Effective Date Prior to January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 should no longer throw
  any errors in relation to the Cutblock Merchantable Area fields on ECAS33 (this field is
  displayed on Appraisals dated Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 and later).

These changes will be reflected in the Technical Specifications for ECAS.
