LOG SALVAGE CLOSURE ORDER

UNDER SECTION 126 OF THE *FOREST ACT*

In view of having received notice that logs have gone astray and pursuant to the provisions of Section 126 of the *Forest Act*, the area described below is declared a closed area in so far as the marine salvage of logs is concerned.

This closure order is in effect from 1200 hours June 16, 2022 until 1200 hours June 25, 2022 or until a subsequent order rescinds, amends or extends the closure.

DESCRIPTION OF CLOSED AREA

- From a starting point at the mouth of Port Harvey extending along the shoreline in a NE direction to Chatham Channel
 - Following Chatham Channel in a NW direction to Knight inlet in the vicinity of Minstrel Island
 - Following the northern shore of West Cracroft Island for a distance of 11km to the tip of Bend Island and then turning north across Turnour Island to the eastern tip of the Lady Islands and then due north to the northern shore of Knight Inlet
 - East along the northern shore of Knight inlet to a point 5 km east of the southern tip of Viscount Island then due south to the southern shore of Knight Inlet
 - West along the shoreline to Chatham Channel and then continuing along the shoreline in a SE direction to Call Inlet
 - Encompassing the entirety of Call Inlet and Boughey Bay to the south
 - From Boughey Bay along the shore line to a point due south of the entrance of Port Harvey and then north to the POC.
- The volume is from the Frederick Bay timber sale in Seymour Inlet.
 - 151 bundles were in the tow with an estimated volume of 12,835m³ (85m³ bundle average)
 - The Timbermark on all bundles is A1488.
 - Log recovery is underway and further assessments are ongoing.
