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#### **Licensee NROS Portal Guide**

#### What is the NROS Portal?

The Natural Resource Online Services (NROS) is a portal where licensees have the ability to electronically submit applications for Road Use Permits and Non Spatial Cutting Permit Amendments, Road Permit Amendments (Reassigns and retires), and Road Notifications.

#### So why are we now doing these applications in the NROS Portal?

We are now doing these NROS Portal applications to integrate them into the electronic world and into our corporate databases that we need for the efficient managing of our resources. This includes everything for inventory, planning, reporting and analysis.

Also, Road Use Permits have now been added to RRS (Resource Roads System) which includes the attribute data. This includes the spatial layer in the British Columbia Geographic Warehouse (BCGW). The layer name is called:

WHSE\_FOREST\_TENURE.FTEN\_RUP\_SECTION\_LINES\_SP

#### **Road Related NROS applications**

Road Authorizations as noted above consist of the following:

Amend RUP New RUP RP Amendment (Retires and Reassigns) Terminate RUP

RUP = Road Use Permit RP = Road permit

#### **Important Road Information for Licensees**

An FSR Project number is also called the Forest File id, or the FSR number. You can find it on the BC Geographic Warehouse (BCGW) layer:

#### WHSE\_FOREST\_TENURE.FTEN\_ROAD\_SECTION\_LINES\_SVW.

Road Use Permit information can be found on the BCGW layer:

**WHSE\_FOREST\_TENURE.FTEN\_RUP\_SECTION\_LINES\_SP.** This layer has basic information for the RUPs including the client number, location code and the legal RUP number.

**Amendment vs. New** (FTA and RRS Submissions) – When a specific type of FTA submission is first submitted for a block it will have a status of "new", as changes or updates occur for the submission area, the later submissions will have a status of "amendment". In RRS, when a road is first created or submitted it will also have a status of "new". As changes or updates occur for the road network, these later submissions will have a status of "amendment".

**Branches** – A Forest Service Road is denoted as a B40 Tenure Type in RRS. FSR "sections" are referred to Branches, while Road Permits are referred to as Sections. Branches have 75m (37.5m each side) widths and consist of a *Branch Number* (01, 02, 03, 04, etc.) and usually a *Branch Name* (Smith Lake, Smith Lake 1200, Smith Lake 2500, etc.).

**Directionality** – The direction of the spatial linework as digitized from start to end. The start of the line consists of the Point of Commencement (PoC) and the end of the line consists of the Point of Termination (PoT). Road directionality for all road tenure submissions should be opposite direction of hauling. Direction should be to the wilderness.

**Forest Service Road (FSR)** - A road constructed, modified, or maintained by the Minister under FSR the provisions of the Forest Act or declared a Forest Service Road. FSRs are used to provide access to managed forest land.

**Reassign** – the process of reassigning (or transferring) the ownership of a FSR or RP to another Licensee or Ministry organization.

**Retire** – Moving the tenure / file to Harvesting Complete Status (HC) in the attribute field within FTA and RRS and also moving the spatial component to "Life Cycle Status" of 'RETIRED" within the BCGW. This is the mechanics of the retire functionality, but please note that many steps are required before a tenure can become retired, most notably any legal obligations are first met.

**Road Permit** - An agreement entered into under Part 8 of the Forest Act to allow R for the construction or modification of a forest road to facilitate access to timber planned for harvest.

**Road Use Permit** - A road use permit (RUP) is required to use Forest Service Roads to carry out industrial uses, including oil and gas activities.

**Sections** - Refers to Road Permit or Special Use Permits sections, just as FSRs sections are referred to as Branches. Sections have 75m (37.5m each side) widths and consist of a *Section Number* (1100, 1100A, 1100B, 1100C, etc.) and sometimes Section *Name* (Smith Lake 1100, Smith Lake Mile 1100A, etc). Keep it short and do not use symbols like /, &, etc.

#### An FSR file has the following:

- Project Number (Tenure or file number) 4 or 5 digits.
- Project Name usually named after a natural feature like BIG LAKE.
- Branch ID this is a 2 or 3 numeric number.
- Branch Name usually named after another natural feature sometimes corresponding to the project name.

Example of an FSR Project "network", depicted by the green linework:



## **Branches and Segments**

A given Forest Service Road has one unique branch name per branch, or road "section". An FSR <u>segment</u> is a subcategory of a FSR branch and you can also have several FSR segments for one FSR branch. FSR "sections" are referred to as "branches" to help differentiate them from Road Permit "sections."



#### Connectivity

Connectivity is the connection of one FSR branch to another. It can be the quality of the spatial line connecting at a vertex or the connection of branch roads on the ground.

Each FSR project number in RRS has a network of branches. There may be only one branch in a project or as many as hundreds. The rule of thumb is the same as road permits which is to keep the projects within a particular drainage or area of the district.

In most cases an FSR project/network has a mainline or branch that starts at a highway or municipal road (maintained by MOTI or the municipality). The mainline branch should be branch ID 01. The other branches connect off this mainline. The diagram below shows an example of this connection. The mainline 6261.01 is connected to a municipal road and the other branches connect off of 6261.01. Try and keep the branches in sequential order going up the mainline. This is not always attainable due to branches further up the mainline may have been built before the branches closer to the start of the mainline.



On the road sections and road segments BCGW layer, these connecting branches must share the same vertex at the Point of Commencement (POC) of the branch connected off of the mainline.

Branches travelling over multiple districts will need to be broken into different projects for administration purposes.

#### Directionality

The direction of the spatial linework as digitized from start to end. The start of the line consists of the Point of Commencement (PoC) and the end of the line consists of the Point of Termination (PoT). Road directionality for all road tenure submissions should be opposite direction of hauling. Direction should be to the wilderness.

Example below shows the direction of the branches on this project. POT shown with an arrow at the end of the FSR branch.

## FSR and Road Permit Letter / Digit Format

Road Permits must have the following format – R plus 5 digits – ex. R00123, R12345

Forest Service Roads must have the following format – 4 or 5 digits – ex. 1253 / 12345

Associated Tenure / Authorization ID must also be included in the information. This is usually the connecting blocks within the associated road tenure. Associated Cutting Permits must have the following format – 5 digits ex. A12345. TA1234

Note for Blanket RUPs – The NROS Portal gives you the ability to apply for multiple Projects on ONE RUP application.
