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PRIVATE TIMBER MARK APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

All Timber Mark Applications require the following:

- **Full legal name, current mailing address, BC Driver's License number (or BCID, BC Services, Birth Certificate number or other valid ID), birth date and signature of all landowners;** or person who is signing on behalf of a company. We do not accept electronic signatures.

If not applying in person, please provide a photocopy or scan of ID.

- Only the owners of the land in fee simple, registered owners of the timber OR owners of an Agreement to Purchase as registered at the Land Titles Office can apply.
- If the property is in two or more names, it is necessary for **all** landowners to complete and sign the application form. The first individual listed on the application form will then become the Primary Mark Holder.
- If landowner(s) are unable to sign the application and have a Power of Attorney (POA), the person named on the POA may sign. The POA document must be also included in the application submission.
- Multiple properties may be included on one application provided the owners of all the properties are the same and are within the same Natural Resource District.

Please also note the following:

- A Timber Mark Certificate is required to transport timber.
- A Private Timber Mark is not an authority to cut. Please check with your applicable local government to determine if additional approvals are required.
- The Private Timber Mark is valid for 5 years or until the ownership of the land (or timber if different) has changed. A Private Timber Mark is not transferable.
- A Timber Mark application can take up to 21 working days to process and be issued once a completed application has been submitted.
