Pursuant to Section 94(1) of the *Forest Act* and Section 2 of the *Timber Marking and Transportation Regulation*, a person must transport unscaled timber to a scale site designated by a Forest Officer. Timber may only be scaled at the sites designated in this agreement. **It is an offence** to transport timber to a location other than the designated scale site. The timber mark holder or an authorized company official, and an authorized Ministry Official prior to the beginning of scaling must sign this agreement. This agreement **does not** constitute an approval to harvest timber.
