- 6. Special Use Permits may be subject to annual charge and property taxes.
- 7. First Nations Information Sharing (proponent led) or Consultation (government led) is required.
- 8. Referrals, if required, are conducted by the proponent and submitted with the project application.
- 9. Archaeological, terrain stability, fuel hazard assessments may be required.

SUPs give the authorization for the use and occupation only. Other authorization may be required dependent on the purpose, works or activity. All additional authorizations must be acquired prior to operations (e.g. OLTC for timber removal, WSA Section 11 for works in and about a stream, ENV/Interior Health authorizations for sewage, garbage, air pollution or fuel storage)


