IN THE MATTER OF TREE FARM LICENCE NUMBER 1

AMENDMENT NUMBER 36

---

Whereas the lands described hereinafter are within Tree Farm Licence Number 1;

And whereas British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority requires the aforementioned lands on which to construct a power line;

Therefore pursuant to Clause 11 of the said Tree Farm Licence Number 1 the following lands described in Schedule "B" of the said Tree Farm Licence, more particularly described as being 150 feet on either side of the centre line approximately as shown in red on the attached sketch are herewith withdrawn until clearing and construction of the power line are completed but in any event not beyond June 1st, 1968.

Reserving unto the licensee of the T.F.L. any and all roads constructed by the said licensee.

## MEMO

To the Honourable the Minister

This deletion from the T.F.L. is to permit construction of the B. C. Hydro line from Terrace to Alice Arm. At the termination of this amendment or possibly sooner, when clearing is complete, surveys have been run and the line is in place, a revised amendment will be required to remove 100 feet only, on a permanent basis. The extra width required now is to facilitate the removal of danger trees which fall outside the final 100 foot R/W required by Hydro. Celgar has no objection.
