IN THE MATTER OF FOREST MANAGEMENT LICENCE NUMBER 6

AMENDMENT NO. 6

Whereas a right-of-way for the purpose of removal of forest products is required over the lands described hereinafter which said lands are within Forest Management Licence Number 6.

Therefore pursuant to Clause 15 of the said Forest Management Licence Number 6 the following is herewith withdrawn from the lands designated in Schedule "B" of the said Forest Management Licence that is to say the existing road on Section 4 (S.T.L. 1979^P expired) and Section 9 of Township 4, and Sections 24 and 25 of Township 10, and S.T.L. 9309^P (expired), all in the Rupert Land District, more particularly shown in red on the attached sketch, for the purpose of a right-of-way under Part VI of the "Forest Act"; and the lands so withdrawn are not and shall not be subject to the said Forest Management Licence.

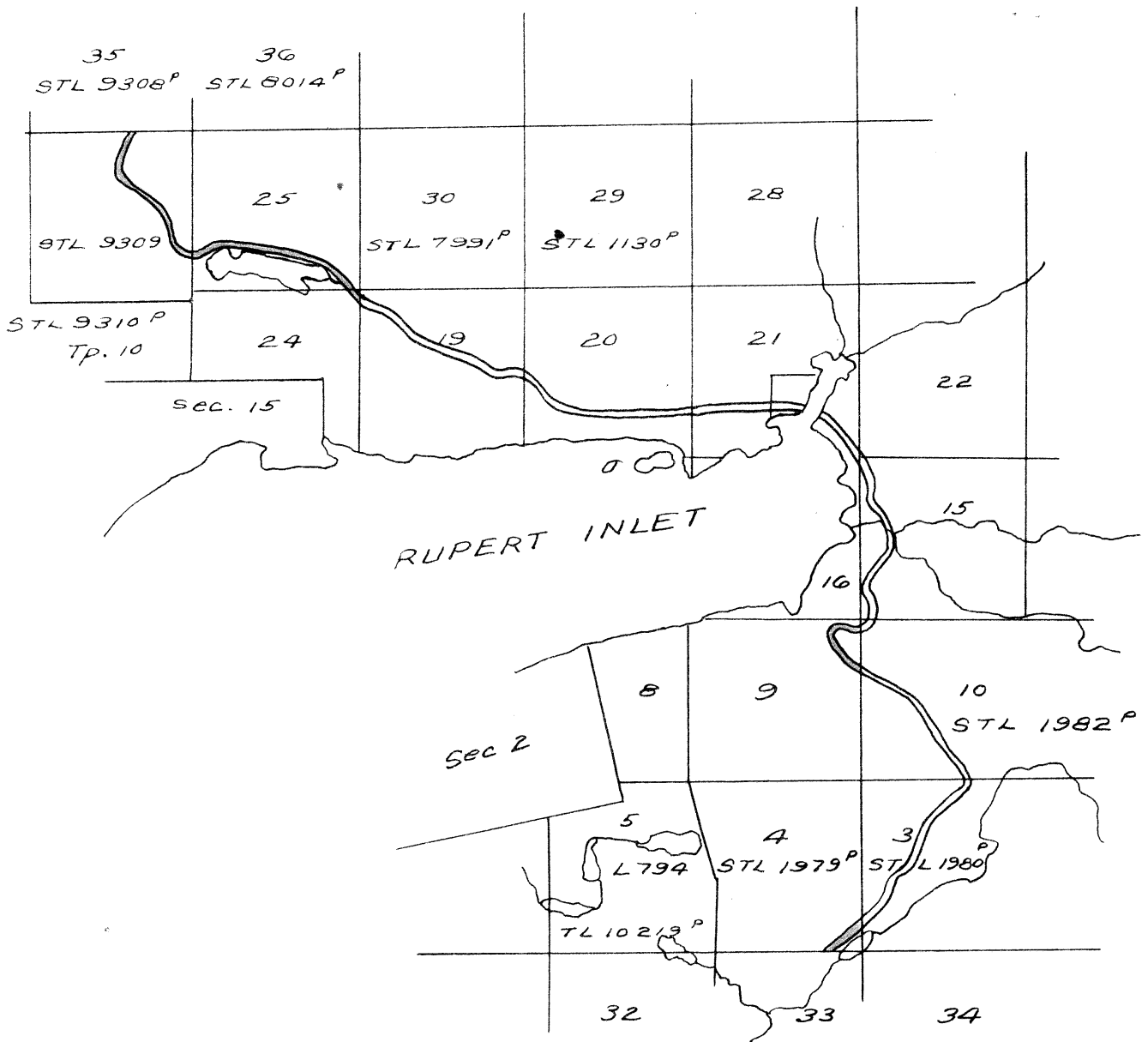
